



South East Integration Network – Illustrations Project

Background

The South East Integration Network is a network of over 70 member organisations working across the south east of Glasgow. The purpose of the network is to promote & celebrate the racial and cultural diversity within the area, and connect and support member groups who support the integration of New Scots (migrants, refugees, and asylum seekers).

The Network does this through monthly network meetings; fortnightly newsletters; promotion of member organisations on social media; a website with resources, news and information; training & capacity building support for member organisations; and facilitation of partnerships between member organisations. The Illustration Project

We are looking for an illustrator to create 15-20 spot illustrations that represent both the services of the network, and the activities of our members. The illustrations will be used on our website, across our social platforms, and on information we circulate amongst our members and mailing list.

Purpose

The purpose of this project is to create a stronger visual identity for SEIN, so that the organisation is more visible to the public and fosters a greater sense of belonging among our members.

Fee & Contract

The **fee is £1,000** for the project, with a **minimum of 15 spot illustrations required**. The contract will be freelance; the contract and completion date will be discussed with the successful candidate before the work begins.

You should have access to your own tools and software needed for the job.

Accessibility and Illustrator Person Specific

As an organisation that works to promote diversity, inclusion, and representation, we are keen to receive applications from illustrators from New Scots and BAME backgrounds, ideally connected to SEIN through a member organisation or with an active connection to the south east of Glasgow.

If you are interested but feel you have specific barriers to applying, please let us know so we can talk about how we can address these.

Two SEIN staff members & one board member will shortlist 3-4 candidates. Those shortlisted will be invited to a short interview (online) where we will further discuss your ideas for the project. We will provide feedback on our decision to all shortlisted candidates.
